Facility updates-

- Issues with scheduled use at Stoneridge Courts especially Sunday mornings
- Community wants more open play time on Sunday mornings and a clearer schedule for the program at Stoneridge Courts (*update: Michelle Stearns sent a revised schedule for Stoneridge courts programs- no Sundays 3/12/14*)
- Concerns about the safety issue with the lamp posts in between courts
- Dana Gill suggested to get pads on the lamp posts immediately
- City announced that pads can't go on yet because courts aren't approved yet
- Dana Gill asked how soon will the courts be approved (*update: still waiting on court approval from city*)
- Community wants a buzzer/blinking light to warn players when lights are about to go off- no warning system at the moment

Program updates-
